LEARN HOW TO:

- Safely utilize hand and power tools for set construction
- Review a script and break it down into its scenic elements
- Interpret set design plans and how to turn them into actual set pieces
- Navigate the Scene Shop and its many tools and uses
- Utilize set construction techniques and practices to build scenery
- Apply basic set painting techniques to a design
- · Assist in a set load-in into the theater
- Employ set dressing to put the finishing touches to the set before Opening Night!
